Perkins Road at I-10 Overpass - Livable Streets and Site Design Study - Community Survey

Survey Conducted on October 17, 2018

Study Area: East Baton Rouge – Perkins Road Commercial District near the I-10 overpass, from Baywood Ave, (West .65 miles) to the South Acadian Throughway.

Overview of Survey Focus

Livable or Living Streets - Living streets combine the goals of Green Infrastructure (including Green Streets and Cool Streets) for reduction of urban heat island effect, and to naturally manage stormwater and improve water quality, with the goals of Complete Streets to provide safe access for all modes of travel and encourage community activity in public spaces. Livable Streets are typically considered a design strategy for urban areas that aims to reduce the speed of motorized traffic, making the surrounding areas more livable and walkable and spaces more attractive to pedestrian, and designed with the flexibility to adapt to climate change and provides environmental benefits.

Complete Streets: Approaching transportation decisions with the intent to provide safe, comfortable, and convenient options for travel by all modes—walking, bicycling, driving, and taking public transportation—and by all users, regardless of age, ability, income, race, or ethnicity. It is a collaborative process that involves multiple community agencies or departments—such as planning, public works, transit agencies, and health departments—and members of the public, including AARP members, smart growth organizations, bicycling and walking advocates, representatives of the disability community, business owners, and other stakeholders. Together, these groups work to shift the goal of transportation projects from "moving automobiles quickly" to "providing safe and efficient access for all users.

Green Infrastructure and Cool Street Strategies: Students will developed strategies and landscape typologies for an innovative integrated systems approach to managing and utilizing stormwater as a resource and will explore the multiple benefits of a sustainable green infrastructure and cool street strategies approach related to community health and well-being, environmental equity, as well as ecological benefits. Students will be challenged to consider the ecological, educational, artistic/poetic, symbolic and expressive potential of water in their proposed design.





Q2 Gender







Q6 How do you get to the Perkins Road District typically?





Q7 Business Owners Only:How many customers a day do you think you have?






Q8 Business Owners Only: What is your customers' age range?




Q11 Business Owners Only:How likely will you stay in this location for the next 5 or more years?


Q12 Housing Residents Only:Do you own or rent your primary home — or do you have some other type of living arrangement?




