Community Open House Events Offer I-10 Project Update and Input on Noise Wall Options

Baton Rouge — The Louisiana Department of Transportation and Development (DOTD) invites the public to a pair of open house events offering information about the I-10 Improvements project through Baton Rouge. Officials and project professionals will be on hand to answer questions about noise walls and other aspects of the project.

Public input will be sought on material options for noise control walls which will line the improved interstate. Physical examples of the proposed materials will be on exhibit, renderings of design options will be on display, and both online and paper polling options will be provided to attendees.
